AMEE AND AMDE ANNUAL CONFERENCES, 1987, DUBLIN

6 November 1986

The local organizing committee for the 1987 Annual Conferences of AMEE and AMDE has confirmed the following schedule for the meetings in Dublin:

AMEE CONFERENCE "The Continuum of Medical Education; Basic, Postgraduate and CME"

Venue: ROYAL COLLEGE OF SURGEONS IN IRELAND

Wednesday 9 September - Registration.

Thursday 10 September - Opening Session. Conference sessions. Evening State Reception

Friday 11 September - Conference sessions. Conference dinner.

Saturday 12 September - Further sessions. Close. Lunch.

Conference accommodation, in Trinity College, will be available until Sunday morning.

On a number of occasions, delegates to AMEE Conferences have expressed a wish to present papers of their own studies of medical education. The Executive has now agreed that time should be set aside at the next AMEE Conference, possibly in parallel with other activities, for short papers to be presented. This arrangement will be publicized early in 1987 but I am writing to you now in the hope that you will draw it to the attention of potential contributors. I also enclose a draft notice calling for papers on which your comments would be most welcome.

The revised Final Programme for the 1987 Annual Conferences of AMEE and AMDE is about to be sent to you from Dublin, including information on the Regional Session to address the Programme and Strategy of the World Federation for Medical Education on Wednesday 9th September.
